Throughout the program, students will have their studies richly complemented through specialized Reach Ahead activities and Experiential Learning activities such as gallery visits, interviews with professional artists, portfolio day, large scale exhibits, field trips and other opportunities to tie academic learning and studio practice with real life applications. By signing up for Creative Arts, you will complete all of your SHSM certification requirements and have access to art specific co-op opportunities.

Project work within this course is designed to foster an element of community involvement and driven by personal expression and interest. Creative Arts is a studio program which enables students to build a strong portfolio for submission to post-secondary institutions in areas such as Fine Art, Illustration, Animation, Architecture, Fashion, and Graphic Design. Creative Arts has been supporting young artists successfully pursue their career goals in the arts and design since 1990.

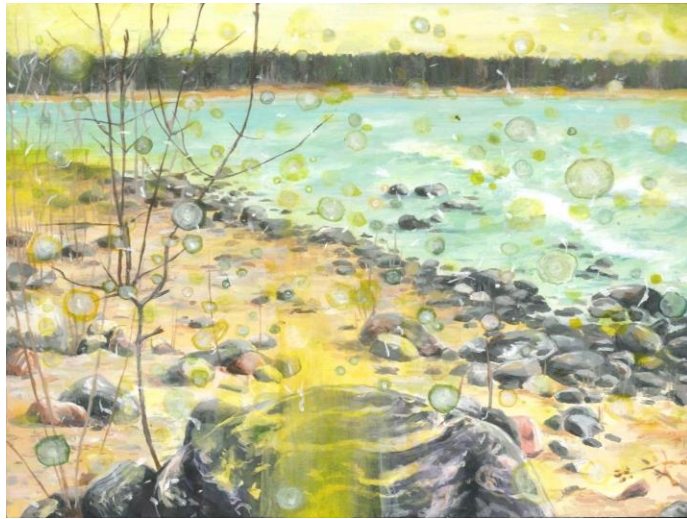
