

Lift Truck Training



Program Overview:

Our Lift Truck / Forklift Operator Training Program consists of a half-day classroom theory session, which covers all aspects of lift truck safety and operation. An individual practical operating session will follow. Operating techniques shall be assessed - incorrect methods shall be identified and corrected. The pre-shift inspection procedures (circle checks) are reviewed. New operators with limited or no operating experience will require practical training at your site prior to the practical operating test. This program will provide the participant with the necessary knowledge to safely and correctly operate your workplace specific class of lift truck(s) and attachments.

Training Content:

- Based on CSA Standard B335-15
- Ministry of Labour Expectations
- OHS & Regulation 851 including – Roles and Responsibilities
- Workplace Hazard Identification and Risk Assessments
- Fork Truck Classifications
- Training and Qualifications for the Lift Truck Operator
- Safe Practices and Procedures
- Pedestrian Safety
- Pre-operation inspections
- Stability Triangle, Load Stacking, Traveling with & without a load
- Program Can be Tailored to – Propane, Electric or Diesel – powered Lift Trucks
- Programs Available for Counterbalance, Narrow Aisle, Order Picker, Power Walkies, etc...



Course Duration:

- Eight (8) Hours dependent upon number of participants

NOTE: As laid out in [Occupational Health and Safety Act, S 25\(2\)\(A\),\(D\) and \(H\) Regulation 851](#) has been amended to include the requirement for training and certification of powered lift truck operators. Employers are now required to ensure that workers have received instruction, training and testing in the operation of powered lift trucks and forklifts. Workers must be familiar with the operating procedures of the truck or forklift that they will be operating and able to demonstrate competency in accordance with the [Ministry of Labour's](#) "Guideline for The Safe Operation and Maintenance of Powered Lift Trucks."
