SHSM Program Description:

The **ICT SHSM** program offered at Ernestown Secondary School **provides students in grades 11 and 12 with learning opportunities related to the dynamic and expanding information technology economic sector**. In addition to the secondary school technology courses available to them, **ICT SHSM students are funded to pursue certificate courses** (ex. in-person health and safety training, short on-line technology courses), **experiential learning activities** (ex. technology-related workshops/tutorials), **reach ahead experiences** (ex. post-secondary institution visits), and **technology sector experiences** (ex. Technology company visits). If students undertaking the ICT SHSM complete all the program requirements by the time of their Grade 12 graduation, they will earn a special seal on their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) indicating this achievement.

The **ICT SHSM program at Ernestown emphasizes learning about the creative use of computers** through the study of a wide variety of topics including: **web application development, 3D modelling, 3D printing, electronics, robotics, and video game/virtual reality creation**. At Ernestown, each ICT SHSM student has access to an advanced lab containing dual-monitor gaming workstations running professional design software such as Unity3D (unity.com) and Blender (blender.org). The lab is also home to new and emerging technologies such as a pair of Cubicon Style 3D Printers, a wide array of electronics such as micro: bit and associated electronics and a class set of Oculus Quest virtual reality headsets!
