### SHSM Program Description:

The ICT SHSM program offered at Ernestown Secondary School provides students in grades 11 and 12 with learning opportunities related to the dynamic and expanding information technology economic sector. In addition to the secondary school technology courses available to them, ICT SHSM students are funded to pursue certificate courses (ex. in-person health and safety training, short on-line technology courses), experiential learning activities (ex. technology-related workshops/tutorials), reach ahead experiences (ex. post-secondary institution visits), and technology sector experiences (ex. Technology company visits). If students undertaking the ICT SHSM complete all the program requirements by the time of their Grade 12 graduation, they will earn a special seal on their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) indicating this achievement.

The ICT SHSM program at Ernestown emphasizes learning about the creative use of computers through the study of a wide variety of topics including: web application development, 3D modelling, 3D printing, electronics, robotics, and video game/virtual reality creation. At Ernestown, each ICT SHSM student has access to an advanced lab containing dual-monitor gaming workstations running professional design software such as Unity3D (unity.com) and Blender (blender.org). The lab is also home to new and emerging technologies such as a pair of Cubicon Style 3D Printers, a wide array of electronics such as micro: bit and associated electronics and a class set of Oculus Quest virtual reality headsets!
